Submission of Sample:

- All samples must be drawn in 10ml red top tubes without serum separators. Please do not remove sera from original tube.
- All necessary precautions must be taken to avoid exposing the serum to temperature extremes. Avoid having the package sit on a hot loading dock or directly on ice.
- Do not send packages for weekend delivery.
