SUBJECT: LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR RESIDENTS

I. POLICY

It is the policy of North Carolina Baptist Hospitals, Inc. that all residents in graduate medical education at this institution will be provided with professional liability coverage for the duration of his/her training including tail coverage. The coverage to be provided will be consistent wit the institution's coverage for other medical/professional practitioners.

II. PURPOSE

The coverage will provide legal defense and protection against awards from claims reported or filed after the completion of graduate medical education if the alleged acts or omissions of the residents are within the scope of the education program.

III. PROCEDURE

The hospital will provide current residents and applicants for residency with the details of the institution's professional liability coverage for residents during interviews, orientation and/or when requested by the resident.
