DynaMed is an evidence-based, clinical reference tool created by physicians for physicians and other health care professionals for use primarily at the point-of-care. Using the best available evidence for clinical decision making, DynaMed can help improve patient outcomes and reduce health care costs. It contains clinically organized summaries of more than 3,000 topics and is updated daily from review of research literature. It also is available for IPhone, Droid, and Blackberry.

PubMed Mobile

A new version of PubMed Mobile is now available for use with Smart phones and other mobile devices. PubMed Mobile provides a simplified mobile-friendly Web interface to search PubMed. Simply enter your keywords in the search box and click "Search". The initial (Summary) display includes the article title, first author's name, journal title abbreviation, and year of publication. A link to Standard PubMed is available at the bottom of all PubMed Mobile pages. PubMed Mobile does not include specialized search pages, such as Limits and Advanced search, or added features, such as My NCBI, Clipboard, or LinkOut/Outside Tool. To use these and other PubMed features, display your retrieval in Standard PubMed via the link at the bottom of the screen.

The Carpenter Library journal icons are not visible, but clicking on the publisher link to the full text should allow you to see the articles if it is one of our subscribed titles.

Faculty Publications would like to announce a new shortcut for searching the publications in our database: http://www.wakehealth.edu/facpubs. Below are some tips for submitting publications:

- Check the Faculty Publications database before submitting publication items in case the article has already been added.
- Items are not entered until they are published with citation data, such as volume, issue, page numbers, etc. "Epub ahead of print" items are considered still "in proof" or "in press" and are not entered until we have more complete citation data.
- We encourage you to submit published items throughout the year to avoid the rush at year's end.

Ektron Training in the Library

Who should come + How to sign-up

Ektron is the content management system (CMS) program used by departments to edit and maintain Medical Center websites. Kim McBride, on the library staff, is the Ektron instructor and offers classes held in the library. She teaches both basic and advanced classes. Once trained, patrons will have access to CMS to maintain their sites according to the Web Conventions identified by Communications, Marketing & Media.

Patrons who are interested, and qualified by their department, must register online. To sign up, go the library classes page, http://www.wakehealth.edu/Library/Services/Classes-in-the-Library.htm, and use the Ektron Registration link at the end of the class description.

Patrons must fill out one form for each class, basic and/or advanced. The basic class is required before attending the advanced class. Registration does not guarantee a class spot. Confirmation emails are sent once a person is added to a class roster. If a class is full, people may be added to a wait list.
