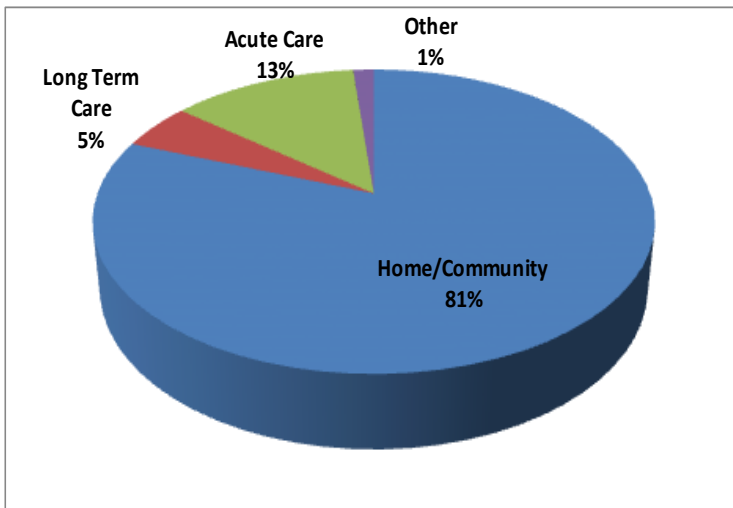

Self Care	93%	60%
Bowel & Bladder Control	91%	35%
Locomotion (Walking/Stairs)	103%	108%
Bed, Toilet, & Chair Transfers	86%	72%
Communication	39%	22%
Interaction/Memory/Problem Solving	39%	19%
