Dr. Woods is Associate Professor of Pediatrics/Genomics at the Medical College of Wisconsin. She is a member of the Human and Molecular Genetics Center and the Children's Research Institute at MCW. Dr. Woods' laboratory focuses on identifying genes involved in type 2 diabetes using rat models. Her lab uses outbred heterogeneous stock rats to identify relatively small chromosomal regions that play a role in diabetes-related phenotypes.
