Dr. Wharam conducts health services research on the impact of health policies on health care quality, outcomes, and vulnerable populations. He leads or has led seven major projects examining effects of high-deductible health plans (HDHPs) on appropriate health care and has published early studies of modern HDHPs. He co-leads the Harvard site's NIDDK/CDC NEXT-D study (U58DP02719) that examines the impact of HDHPs on diabetes quality, outcomes, and disparities, and is a Principal Investigator of the follow-up NEXT-D2 study (U18DP006122) examining how cost-sharing reductions affect diabetes patients enrolled in Health Savings Account HDHPs.
