Dr. Mayer-Davis studies the epidemiology and natural history of type 1 and type 2 diabetes with a focus on youth and young adults. Her work involves both observational epidemiology and translational research to develop, implement and evaluate interventions designed to facilitate improvement in diabetes self-management, metabolic status, and quality of life particularly for youth and young adults with type 1 diabetes. Dr. Mayer-Davis is currently the national co-chairperson of the SEARCH for Diabetes in Youth Study, a multi-center study funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases (NIDDK).
