Dr. D'Alessio is Professor of Medicine at the Duke University School of Medicine and Director of the Division of Endocrinology. He is a staff physician at the Durham VA Medical Center where he has consultative practices in the lipid and endocrinology clinics. Dr. D'Alessio has a primary research interest in the regulation of glucose tolerance and abnormalities that lead to type 2 diabetes. Work in his lab is directed at the interplay between circulating glucose, GI hormones and neural signals to control insulin secretion with a primary focus on the gut peptide GLP-1 and its role in normal physiology, type 2 diabetes and bariatric surgery.
