

## INTERN DAY 5

### Course objectives:

Duration:	Two hours, solo performance
Faculty:	One instructor/operator
Location:	Simulation suite and debriefing room
Schedule:	Blocked out of OR; end of first month
Purpose:	Assimilation of course objectives to conduct a complete general anesthetic without assistance.
Preparation:	Review anesthesia machine checkout procedures Review all concentrations and dosages of typical drugs Memorize and review your induction sequence Anticipate common anesthetic complications Review the principles of an efficient emergence sequence

At the end of the fifth and final day, the anesthesia intern will:

- Perform an efficient and thorough anesthesia machine checkout
- Prepare the patient for general anesthesia and induce within five minutes
- Administer appropriate drugs and dosages through memory
- Select appropriate basic airway adjuvants
- Conduct the entire process without assistance
- Recognize and respond to several complications Avoid the typical reasons for delayed emergence from general anesthesia
- Demonstrate the proper sequence for emergence from general anesthesia
- Conduct an efficient emergence from anesthesia
- Maintain an accurate and timely anesthetic record
- Critically evaluate their own performance in debriefing
