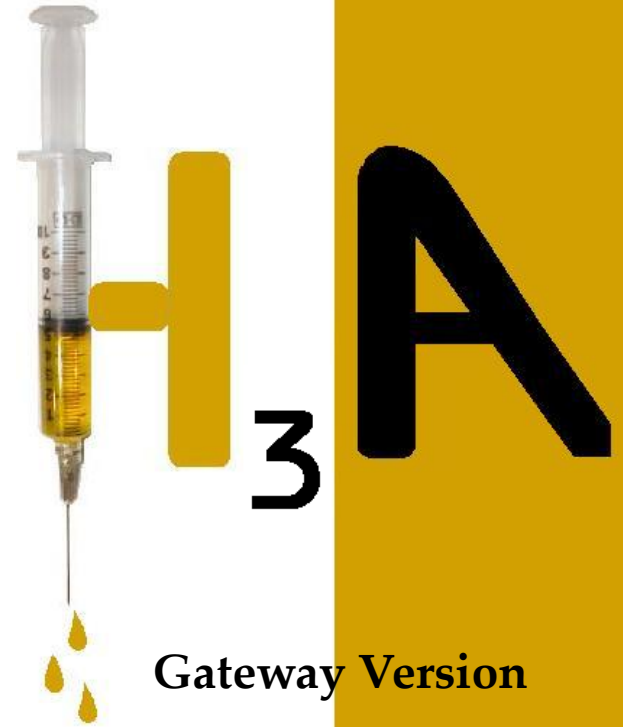

Gateway Version

A three-fold developmental program to introduce ICU nurses to anesthesia nursing and develop valuable attributes among anesthesia program applicants.

Tri-Development Concept

This two day workshop will immerse you in a "Fast Forward" learning experience designed to provide you with valuable insight into the nurse anesthesia profession. It will also provide you with tools to help you gain admission to a program.

Created around the concept that a successful anesthesia applicant requires technical knowledge (*head*), a self-awareness of their personality, strengths and weaknesses (*heart*), and competence with manual skills (*hands*), this program will expose you to unique and experiential learning opportunities that will lay a strong foundation for your future academic endeavors.

Designed for those with an interest in nurse anesthesia, including those applying to a program, the course presents academic concepts (head) important to the advanced ICU nurse, while also weaving in a focus on personal development (heart) and hands-on clinical skills application (hands).

Special activities include the *Ultimate ICU Challenge*, where participants team up to put their ICU skills to the test against a high-fidelity human patient simulator.



Curriculum

The seminar consists of classroom lectures, group discussions and hands-on laboratory learning. Content was derived from the input of ICU managers, Directors of top Nurse Anesthesia Programs and current nurse anesthesia students. Seminar faculty includes CRNA clinical instructors and anesthesia program administrators. Education credits may be applied toward renewal of RN licensure and as *synergy CREPs* for CCRN re-certification.

Developmental Realm: Head



Shock: Differentiation of different types and treatment. **Respiratory:** Ventilator management and blood gas interpretation. **Pharmacology:** Pharmacologic principles, propofol and other hypnotic infusions. **Monitoring:** BIS, ICP, hemodynamic and nerve stimulator monitoring.

Developmental Realm: Heart

Mask ventilation, interpretation of heart and lung sounds, 12-lead ECG, IV insertion skills. **Integration:** High-fidelity human patient simulation lab– putting it all together in the Ultimate ICU Challenge.
