

Nurse Anesthesia Program Withdrawal Policy

Withdrawal

Any student who wishes to withdraw from the program shall submit to the Program Director a written resignation with the reason for his/her decision. In addition, the student must submit his/her final accounting of clinical experiences to date, hospital identification card, medical center keys and any other materials belonging to the Hospital. Please see the Exit Interview Policy and Tuition Refund Policy for further procedures. For withdrawals which occur before 50% of the course has been completed, the transcript will reflect a withdrawal. If the withdrawal occurs after the 50% point in the course, the transcript will reflect either withdraw passing or withdraw failing ("WP" or "WF"), depending on the student's grade as of the date of withdrawal.

If a student wishes to reenter the program following voluntary withdrawal, they must reapply and meet with the Admissions Committee. Readmission is contingent on committee recommendations and availability of clinical positions for student experience.
